..... from the **Meeting of the Congregation on 5th July**

Last Monday evening 64 members of the Congregation gathered to hear various reports about aspects of our church life – some reports had been published in summary form in the *Bulletin* recently but were given in more detail at the meeting. (Copies are available from the Office.)

Significantly, the meeting decided to allocate all of the money to be raised at our Fete in October to all seven of the Congregation Outreach Projects suggested by members:

Hotham Mission	\$3000
Kids Hope	\$1000
Frontier Services	\$3870
Friends of Ermera	\$5500
Kenya Outreach Group	\$3130
Friends of Baguia	\$3000
Cheryl Emms	\$500

In the event that more or less than \$20,000 is raised by the fete, the surplus or shortfall will be allocated pro rata to the difference between the requested amount and the allocated amount, with the proviso that the allocations to Frontier Services and Kids Hope not exceed \$3,870 and \$1,000 respectively. Details of all projects will be advertised in conjunction with the Fete.

The Meeting also had a full briefing from Rev Greg Crowe on progress to date in the search for a Minister of the Word to replace Rev Lynette Dungan. Rev Crowe has been appointed by the Presbytery to chair the Joint Nominating Committee that includes six of our members. A meeting to explain the process in greater detail will be held on Monday 25th July in Room 1.
