### **The New Monthly Bulletin**

The first monthly bulletin will be handed out together with the (separate) weekly bulletin on Sunday 3 July. On subsequent Sundays in July only the weekly bulletin will be handed out but there will be some “left-over” copies of the monthly bulletin available on the table for people who may have missed it on the first Sunday. A similar procedure will apply in August, September ... etc.

### **Reasons for Separating the Weekly and Monthly Bulletins**

The Communications Committee is making this change in response to a widespread view that the weekly bulletin has grown too big and is often not read “cover to cover” resulting in some important information being missed. The idea is that the weekly bulletin will in future be shorter, more concise and focus on matters of a short-term nature, typically the next two weeks. The monthly bulletin will be available every Sunday in that month for people who may have missed it the first week and will contain longer-term information which people can take home and read.

### **Contents**

Essentially the monthly bulletin will contain the following types of advance information which are known at least a month beforehand, in date order:

- Information about worship e.g. Holy Week, Seminars, Prayer Groups, Study Groups etc
- Mission Group Reports and any other reports e.g. Church Council etc
- Monthly Groups - e.g. Adult Group, Men's Fellowship, etc
- Fund-raising events - e.g. Book Sale, Fete, International Dinner etc  
“Keep the date free” - e.g. November “Kountry Dance”.

Being published less frequently we can afford to give this material more space, typically up to an A5 page each and even more in some instances. Information for inclusion in the monthly bulletin should please be provided to the office by the Monday before the first Sunday of the month.
